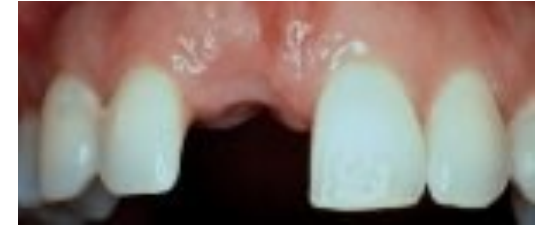

Dental Implants —The Process



(Based on a single missing tooth model)


Book your Consultation

Telephone, email, book online

Consultation

History, examination, X-rays , photos and impressions for study models.



Extractions if necessary


Bone augmentation if necessary. May be done same visit as Implant surgery.

Consent form signed. Implant order placed. 30% deposit

Implant surgery done (30% payment)



Impression-taking (20% payment)

Measurement for final crown / bridge



Fitting post & crown (20% balance)



Review in 6 months (May be done by your own dentist)

Dental Implants—Frequently asked questions.

What are dental Implants ? A dental implant is a small metal peg inserted in the jawbone to replace the root part of a missing tooth. They are made of titanium and placed in the tooth-less portion of the jaw under local anaesthesia. The implant then acts as an anchor to replace the missing single tooth or several teeth.

How successful are they? With proper patient selection and care, the success rate of modern implants is about 98%.

What can cause failure? Poor oral hygiene, excessive smoking, severe gum disease, some medical conditions such as severe liver disease, uncontrolled diabetes etc

How long do they last? Modern research suggests 25 years to life!

How long does the whole process take? This depends on how complicated the whole process is. A single missing tooth gap with healthy bone and gum could be completed in 6—12 weeks.

Is the treatment painful? You will feel the discomfort of the anaesthetic needle when the site is being numbed up. The treatment process itself is painless. After the initial surgery you would need to take simple pain-killers for about 3-5 days. Some patients have had painkillers for only 1 day. Some of our patients did not use any at all!

Am I a suitable patient? Your dentist and / or implant surgeon will carry out a detailed assessment including assessment of your general state of health and a dental examination and investigations including x-rays and impressions for study models. A decision would then be made to see if you are suitable or would need other treatment before having dental implants.

What are the advantages of dental implants?

You will be able to enjoy your food as much as with natural teeth, Your new teeth will be fixed securely into

your mouth unlike dentures.. There is also no need to have plastic or metal components covering other parts of your mouth. There would be no need to damage natural teeth as with tooth-retained bridges. Dental Implants also give you good facial support and restore confidence.

How much do they cost? This depends on a few factors such as how many implants you need, any necessary treatment needed before the implants such as extractions, bone grafting, gum treatment etc. It also depends on what your implant is going to support.

Who will carry out my treatment? This can be done by a dentist experienced in Implant surgery, a specialist Oral Surgeon, prosthodontist, periodontist or other specialist.

Implant surgery is carried out in our practices by **Dr Wale Towolawi**. Wale is a specialist Oral Surgeon who is both dentally and medically qualified and has performed implant surgery for many years both across London and the home counties. As indicated on the other side of this page, you will have an initial consultation including an examination, x-rays and if necessary, impressions for study models. This is to assess if you are suitable for implant treatment and for treatment planning. The procedure will then be explained to you and any questions you may have answered. You will then be given a consent form to grant permission to have the treatment done. The entire procedure should take 3 –4 visits depending on how straight-forward your treatment is.
